Registration Information

(Twin Cities metro area ONLY)

- Sessions have limited enrollment (all grades refer to grades for fall 2011):
 - Class for students entering 3rd & 4th grade: 12 students
 - Class for students entering 5th & 6th grade: 16 students
 - Class for students entering 7th & 8th grade: 14 students
 - Class for SAI Fractions: 12-14 students
- Register early – sessions often fill quickly.
- Your registration must include payment for the full tuition amount, of which \$50 is non-refundable. If we cancel a class due to low registrations, you will receive a full refund (i.e., we don't keep the \$50).
- Students in grades 4-5-6 (for fall 2011) can have an all-day option by registering for both a morning class and the afternoon SAI Fractions class. Fee for this all-day option = morning tuition **PLUS** afternoon tuition **PLUS** \$25 noon supervision. No lunch or refrigeration is provided.
- Make checks payable to Algebra for Kids, LLC.
- ***Credit card payment is not available at this time.***
- Registrants will receive an **email** confirmation only. As class time approaches, we will send an email with directions, information on parking, dropoff and pickup times, etc.
- Classrooms are handicap accessible. Notify us if you need assistance due to physical disabilities so that any necessary arrangements can be made.
- SAI tuition is eligible for an educational tax credit or tax deduction on Minnesota state taxes. Discuss this with your tax preparer.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Openings caused by late cancellations are hard to fill, as families on waiting lists have often made other plans by the time a late opening arises. Because of this, our cancellation policy is as follows:

If we receive notice this many days

before the start of your session.....then refund will be:

- 22 days or more prior...
 - 100% less the \$50 non-refundable deposit
- less than 21 days prior...
 - nothing

If we cancel a class due to low registrations, you will receive a full refund (i.e., we don't keep the \$50 deposit).
